Requirements

Open to composers of all nationalities and ages. A work for solo guitar (no more than 12 minutes; 8 minutes or less preferred). Submitted works must be composed for the six-stringed classical guitar. Alternate tunings are acceptable. Fixed media and/or live electronics may be included. No published or previously awarded compositions should be submitted. Multiple works may be submitted with an application fee of \$20 for each work, which should be submitted online at the payment link provided at migf.fiu.edu/2020/composition-competition. After completing payment, you will be provided an "order number". Please enter this "order number" above. Application fees are non-refundable.

Submission Guidelines

The following materials should be submitted via email with attachments to mozgen@fiu.edu by January 5, 2020. The subject line of the email should read "MIGF Composition Competition 2020" followed by your full name.

- Score professionally typeset (e.g. Finale, Sibelius) or legibly handwritten and put on a PDF. All pages of the PDF should be anonymous (without the real name of the composer). The first page of score should be labeled with the **Pseudonym** (nickname) given on this form, title of the work, and date of composition only.
- If the composition includes electronics, provide the tape or maxpat file or a website link for the fixed media:

- If available, a recording of the submitted work in mp3 audio file format is recommended (MIDI is acceptable).
- This completed and signed application form (scanned PDF with signature).

Adjudication and Prizes

Judges have the right to award all or some of the prizes or none. The winner will receive \$500 cash prize. The winning composition will be performed at MIGF. The winner and honorable mention(s) will receive a free festival pass. Winning compositions will be announced on the last day of the festival and posted online at migf.fiu.edu.
